- Be accepted as a full-time student into an accredited two- or four-year college, or university.
- Show academic potential and a sincere desire to further one's education.
- Scholarship awards apply to tuition expenses for 2025-2026 school year beginning the Fall of 2025.
- Unused scholarships shall be returned to the Lahaina Restoration Foundation.
- Children, grandchildren, brothers or sisters of employees or board members of Lahaina Restoration Foundation are ineligible to apply for the LRF scholarship.

The Lahaina Restoration Foundation Scholarship Committee will select the recipients. Awarded scholarship checks will be made out and sent to each recipient's designated college or university.
